

SB 999 (CS) (LC) **West** **SP: King, Tracy O.**
Relating to the requirement that providers of active shooter training at public schools and institutions of higher education obtain a certificate issued by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.

SB 2091 (LC) **West** **SP: Sherman, Sr.**
Relating to the authority of a taxing unit to sell certain seized or foreclosed property to an owner of an abutting property without conducting a public sale.

SB 2325 (LC) **Zaffirini** **SP: Flores/ González, Jessica**
Relating to the eligibility of certain events for funding under the Major Events Reimbursement Program.

SB 2370 (CS) (LC) **Campbell** **SP: Kuempel**
Relating to the division of certain emergency services districts.

SB 2376 **Campbell/ et al.** **SP: Canales/ Cain**
Relating to the issuance of Support Adoption specialty license plates and to the Support Adoption account and certain voluntary contributions to that account.

SB 2453 **Menéndez/ et al.** **SP: Hernandez**
Relating to certain regulations adopted by governmental entities for the building products, materials, or methods used in the construction of residential or commercial buildings.

Relating to measures to address public safety threats in this state presented by transnational criminal activity, including by establishing a Texas Border Force, and to compensate persons affected by those threats; increasing criminal penalties; creating criminal offenses.

HB 18 (CS) (LC) **Slawson/ Patterson/ González, Mary/ Burrows/ Darby/ et al.** **SP: Hughes/ et al.**
Relating to the protection of minors from harmful, deceptive, or unfair trade practices in connection with the use of certain digital services and electronic devices, including the use and transfer of electronic devices to students by a public school.
