Relating to housing certain inmates in state jail felony facilities.

HB 2646 Johnson, Jarvis
Relating to the payment of certain fines and court costs by an inmate during a term of imprisonment or following release from the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.

HB 2743 Smith
Relating to procedures regarding the court-ordered administration of psychoactive medication for criminal defendants who are found incompetent to stand trial.

HB 2805 Leo-Wilson | et al.
Relating to the consideration of certain information by a parole panel in determining whether to release an inmate on parole.

HB 3147 Swanson
Relating to the detainment and housing of juveniles and inmates based on biological sex.

HB 4145 Clardy
Relating to salaries for staff of a private vendor contracting with the Texas Board of Criminal Justice for the operation, maintenance, or management of a correctional facility.

HB 4020 Howard Posting Rule Suspended
Relating to allowing certain inmates to apply for benefits under certain public benefits programs to be provided at the time of discharge or release.

HB 4362 Johnson, Ann Posting Rule Suspended
Relating to the eligibility of certain criminal defendants for an order of nondisclosure of criminal history record information.

HB 4886 Herrero
Relating to sexually violent predators and the prosecution of certain offenses involving prohibited items at correctional or civil commitment facilities; creating a criminal offense.

HB 5114 Sherman, Sr.
Relating to the award of work-for-time credits to certain persons placed on community supervision or released on parole or to mandatory supervision.

HB 5158 Lopez, Ray
Relating to the eligibility of service members and veterans to participate in a veterans treatment court program based on citizenship status.

HB 5177 Lopez, Ray
Relating to the condition of community supervision and procedures applicable to the reduction or termination of a defendant's period of community supervision.
