1           WHEREAS, The untimely and tragic death of U.S. Army Staff  
2 Sergeant Oscar Rodriguez on March 10, 2006, at the age of 27, has  
3 brought a great loss to all who were privileged to know this  
4 exceptional young man; and

5           WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant Rodriguez graduated from A. C. Jones  
6 High School in Beeville before joining the Army in 1996; assigned to  
7 the 25th Infantry Division's First Battalion, 14th Infantry  
8 Regiment, he served a tour of duty in Iraq and was training for  
9 redeployment at the time of his passing; and

10           WHEREAS, Throughout his military career, Staff Sergeant  
11 Rodriguez earned the respect and admiration of peers and commanding  
12 officers alike for the exemplary leadership and technical skills he  
13 displayed in every one of his diverse assignments; and

14           WHEREAS, Our state and nation are fortunate to have young men  
15 and women whose love of country leads them to military service, yet  
16 the death of this exemplary soldier is a reminder that the  
17 preservation of freedom is not without great cost; the passing of  
18 Staff Sergeant Rodriguez is a tremendous loss to his family,  
19 friends, and fellow soldiers, and his sacrifice in service of this  
20 country will not soon be forgotten; now, therefore, be it

21           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas  
22 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the life of  
23 U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Oscar Raul Rodriguez and extend deepest  
24 sympathy to his family: to his wife, Stephanie A. Rodriguez; to his

1 son, Jacob Conner Rodriguez; to his mother, Janie Guerrero Edwards;  
2 to his father, Raul C. Rodriguez, Jr., and his wife, Nova; to his  
3 brother, Carlos Rodriguez; to his sisters, Victoria Alicia  
4 Rodriguez, Pamela Alicia Rodriguez, and Maria Guadalupe Rodriguez;  
5 to his grandmothers, Elda Guerrero and Eva C. Rodriguez; and to all
