- 8 (b-1) Except as provided by Subsection (b-2), the governing
- 9 body of a municipality, for a highway or a part of a highway in an

- 11 designated or marked highway or road of the state highway system, is
- 12 35 feet or less in width, and along which vehicular parking is not
- 13 prohibited on one or both sides of the highway, may declare a lower
- 14 speed limit of not less than 25 miles per hour, if the governing
- body determines that the prima facie speed limit on the highway is
- 16 <u>unreasonable or unsafe.</u>
- 17 (b-2) Subsection (b-1) does not apply to a highway or part
- of a highway that has four or more lanes used for vehicular travel.
- 19 (c) A prima facie speed limit that is altered by the
- 20 governing body of a municipality under Subsection (b) or (b-1) is
- 21 effective when the governing body erects signs giving notice of the
- 22 new limit and at all times or at other times as determined.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
