- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as Simba's Law.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 418.043, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 418.043. OTHER POWERS AND DUTIES. The division shall:
- 9 (1) determine requirements of the state and its
- 10 political subdivisions for food, clothing, and other necessities in
- 11 event of a disaster;
- 12 (2) procure and position supplies, medicines,
- 13 materials, and equipment;
- 14 (3) adopt standards and requirements for local and
- interjurisdictional emergency management plans;
- 16 (4) periodically review local and interjurisdictional
- 17 emergency management plans;
- 18 (5) coordinate deployment of mobile support units;
- 19 (6) establish and operate training programs and
- 20 programs of public information or assist political subdivisions and
- 21 emergency management agencies to establish and operate the
- 22 programs;
- 23 (7) make surveys of public and private industries,
- 24 resources, and facilities in the state that are necessary to carry

- out the purposes of this chapter;
- 2 (8) plan and make arrangements for the availability
- 3 and use of any private facilities, services, and property and
- 4 provide for payment for use under terms and conditions agreed on if
- 5 the facilities are used and payment is necessary;
- 6 (9) establish a register of persons with types of
- 7 training and skills important in disaster mitigation,
- 8 preparedness, response, and recovery;
- 9 (10) establish a register of mobile and construction
- 10 equipment and temporary housing available for use in a disaster;
- 11 (11) assist political subdivisions in developing
- 12 plans for the humane evacuation, transport, and temporary
- 13 sheltering of service animals and household pets in a disaster;
- 14 (12) prepare, for issuance by the governor, executive
- orders and regulations necessary or appropriate in coping with
- 16 disasters;
- 17 (13) $\left[\frac{(12)}{(12)}\right]$ cooperate with the federal government and
- 18 any public or private agency or entity in achieving any purpose of
- 19 this chapter and in implementing programs for disaster mitigation,
- 20 preparation, response, and recovery; and
- 21 $\underline{(14)}$ [(13)] do other things necessary, incidental, or
- 22 appropriate for the implementation of this chapter.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
