- 2 relating to providing psychological counseling to jurors or
- 3 alternate jurors in certain criminal trials.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 56.04, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 7 (f) The crime victim liaison may arrange for not more than
- 8 10 hours of post-trial psychological counseling for a person who
- 9 serves as a juror or an alternate juror in the trial of an offense
- 10 <u>under Section 15.031 or 33.021, Penal Code, or Chapter 19, 21, 22,</u>
- 11 25, or 43, Penal Code, involving graphic evidence or testimony. The
- 12 crime victim liaison may provide the counseling using a provider
- that assists local criminal justice agencies in providing similar
- 14 services to victims.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to the provision of counseling for a juror or an alternate juror in
- 17 a criminal trial that begins on or after the effective date of this
- 18 Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
