4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 9, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 797 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 797. SALE OF NOVELTY LIGHTERS PROHIBITED
8	Sec. 797.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "novelty
9	lighter" means a mechanical or electrical device typically used for
10	lighting cigarettes, cigars, or pipes that has entertaining audic
11	or visual effects, or that resembles in physical form or function
12	articles commonly recognized as appealing to or intended for use by
13	children under 18 years of age. The term includes lighters that
14	resemble cartoon characters, toys, guns, watches, musical
15	instruments, vehicles, toy animals, food, or beverages.
16	Sec. 797.002. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter does
17	not apply to a lighter that:
18	(1) was manufactured before January 1, 1980;
19	(2) does not contain fuel; and
20	(3) does not have a device necessary to produce
21	combustion or a flame.
22	Sec. 797.003. MANUFACTURE, SALE, OR DISTRIBUTION OF NOVELTY
23	LIGHTERS PROHIBITED. A person may not manufacture, sell, or

distribute a novelty lighter.

- 2 marshal may adopt rules to administer this chapter.
- 3 Sec. 797.005. OFFENSE. (a) A person commits an offense if
- 4 the person violates this chapter or a rule adopted under this
- 5 <u>chapter.</u>
- 6 (b) An offense under this chapter is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
