- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 242, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 242.159 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 242.159. AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS. (a) An
- 8 institution shall have available for use at the institution an
- 9 automated external defibrillator, as defined by Section 779.001,
- 10 and shall comply with the training, use, and notification
- 11 requirements of Chapter 779.
- 12 (b) An institution that does not have funds available for
- 13 purposes of Subsection (a) may solicit gifts, grants, or donations
- 14 to purchase or maintain an automated external defibrillator for use
- 15 at the institution.
- 16 (c) The use of an automated external defibrillator must be
- 17 consistent with a resident's advance directive executed or issued
- 18 under Subchapter C, Chapter 166.
- 19 (d) Notwithstanding Section 74.151(b), Civil Practice and
- 20 Remedies Code, Section 74.151(a), Civil Practice and Remedies Code,
- 21 applies to administration of emergency care using an automated
- 22 <u>external defibrillator by an employee or volunteer at an</u>
- 23 institution.
- (e) An institution shall employ at least one person who is

- 1 trained in the proper use of an automated external defibrillator.
- 2 (e-1) An institution is not required to comply with
- 3 Subsections (a) and (e) until September 1, 2012. This subsection
- 4 expires January 1, 2013.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
