school-sponsored shooting sports competition or a shooting sports 1 2 educational activity that is sponsored or supported by the Parks and Wildlife Department or a shooting sports sanctioning 3 4 organization working with the department. 5 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010 6 school year. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9

10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
