- SECTION 2. Article 14.03, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 16
- 17 amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 18 (h) A peace officer may arrest, without a warrant, a person
- 19 who the officer has probable cause to believe has committed an
- offense under Section 30.055, Penal Code, if the peace officer: 20
- (1) at the time of arrest, is acting on a reasonable 21
- suspicion that the person is committing or has committed another 22
- offense for which the peace officer, under the circumstances 23
