| 9 | (1) has not been neutered; |
| 10 | (2) weighs 20 pounds or more; and |
| 11 | (3) is not restrained at all times: |
| 12 | (A) on a leash in the immediate control of a |
| 13 | person; or |
| 14 | (B) in a secure enclosure. |
| 15 | (b) The owner of a dog described by Subsection (a) is liable |
| 16 | for damages to property and for death or bodily injury to a person |
| 17 | resulting from an attack by the dog. |
| 18 | (c) The owner of a dog described by Subsection (a) shall |
| 19 | maintain liability insurance coverage in an amount of not less than |
| 20 | \$100,000 for each occurrence for liability for damages to property |
| 21 | and for death or bodily injury to a person caused by the dog. |
| 22 | (d) A person commits an offense if the person violates |

- 2 <u>in which event it is a Class B misdemeanor.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 822.008, Health and Safety Code, as
- 4 added by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on
- 5 or after the effective date of this Act. A cause of action that
- 6 accrues before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 7 as it existed at the time the cause of action accrued, and that law
- 8 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
