The emergency alert system must use e-mail or telephone notifications in addition to any other alert method the 15 institution considers appropriate to provide timely notification 16 of emergencies affecting the institution or its students and staff. 17 18 (c) At the time a student initially enrolls or registers for courses or a staff member begins employment, the institution shall: 19 (1) obtain a personal telephone number or e-mail 20 21 address from the student or staff member to be used to notify the 22 individual in the event of an emergency; and 23 (2) register the student or staff member in the

institution's emergency alert system.

- 1 (d) A student or staff member may elect not to participate
- 2 in an emergency alert system established under this section. An
- 3 election under this subsection may be submitted electronically or
- 4 in writing, as chosen by the institution, and must be renewed at the
- 5 start of each academic year.
- 6 (e) The personal identifying information obtained from an
- 7 individual for the purpose of the emergency alert system of an
- 8 institution of higher education, including an e-mail address or
- 9 telephone number, is confidential and not subject to disclosure
- 10 under Section 552.021, Government Code.
- 11 (f) Each institution of higher education and private or
- 12 independent institution of higher education shall implement the
- 13 emergency alert system required by this section not later than the
- 14 spring 2012 <u>semester</u>. This subsection expires June 1, 2012.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
