- 4 Texas A&M University--San Antonio as a stand-alone campus; and

- 6 on the House Committees of Defense and Veterans Affairs, Elections,
- 7 Local and Consent Calendars, and Rules and Resolutions; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, he enjoys the love and
- 9 support of his wife of nearly four decades, Angie, and his sons,
- 10 Gabe, Joey, Jaime, and Daniel; and
