## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the collection of certain foreclosure data by the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 51, Property Code, is amended by adding Section 51.0022 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 51.0022. FORECLOSURE DATA COLLECTION. (a) In this 7 section, "department" means the Texas Department of Housing and 8 9 Community Affairs. (b) A person filing a notice of sale of residential property 10 under Section 51.002(b) must submit to the county clerk a completed 11 12 form that provides the zip code for the property. (c) On completion of a sale of real property, the trustee or 13 14 sheriff shall submit to the county clerk a completed form that contains information on whether the property is residential and the 15 16 zip code of the property. (d) Not later than the 30th day after the date of receipt of 17 a form under this section, the county clerk shall transmit the form 18 to the department. 19 (e) The board of the department shall prescribe the forms 20 required under this section. The forms may only request 21 information on whether the property is residential and the zip code 22 23 of the property. 24 (f) The department shall report the information received

## under this section quarterly to the legislature in a format established by the board of the department by rule.

3 SECTION 2. (a) The board of the Texas Department of 4 Housing and Community Affairs shall adopt the forms and rules 5 required by Section 51.0022, Property Code, as added by this Act, 6 not later than January 1, 2012.

7 (b) The change in law made by Section 51.0022, Property 8 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a notice of sale filed on 9 or after January 1, 2012. A notice of sale filed before January 1, 10 2012, is governed by the law in effect on the date the notice is 11 filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
