The chair called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. There being a quorum present, the following business was transacted:

Senator Birdwell moved that the minutes of the March 23, 2011, hearing be approved. The motion was adopted by unanimous consent.

The chair recognized Senator Davis to explain the difference between the committee substitute and the Senate bill as filed. SB 1107 was left pending.

The Chair laid out SB 324 and recognized the author, Senator Jackson, to explain the bill. SB 324 was left pending.

The Chair laid out SB 145 and recognized the author, Senator Hinojosa, to explain the bill. SB 145 was left pending.
