- 3 SECTION 1. Section 466.003(a), Government Code, is amended 4 to read as follows:
- 5 (a) The lottery division is [$\frac{\text{subject to Chapter 325}}{\text{(Texas)}}$
- 6 Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that
- 7 chapter, the division is abolished and this chapter expires August
- 8 31, 2015 [September 1, 2005]. [In the review of the lottery
- 9 division by the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required by this
- 10 section, the sunset commission shall limit its review to the
- 11 appropriateness of recommendations made by the sunset commission to
- 12 the 78th Legislature. In the Sunset Advisory Commission's report
- 13 to the 79th Legislature, the sunset commission may include any
- 14 recommendations it considers appropriate.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 467.002, Government Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 467.002. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The commission is
- 18 subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in
- 19 existence as provided by that chapter, the commission is abolished
- 20 and this chapter [, Chapter 466 of this code,] and Chapter 2001,
- 21 Occupations Code, expire September 1, 2023 [2013].
- 22 SECTION 3. Effective August 31, 2015, Sections 467.101(a)
- 23 and (c), Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 24 (a) The commission has broad authority and shall exercise
- 25 strict control and close supervision over all activities authorized
- 26 and conducted in this state under [+
- 27 [\(\frac{\pmathcal{1}}{1}\)] Chapter 2001, Occupations Code[\(\frac{\pmathcal{+}}{1}\)]
- [(2) Chapter 466 of this code].
- (c) The commission also has the powers and duties granted

3 any other law, the commission's powers and duties related to the
4 state lottery, other than payment of any outstanding prizes awarded
5 for the sale of a lottery ticket before September 1, 2017, expire on
