Amend H.B. 528 by striking all below the enacting clause and
 substituting the following:

3 SECTION 1. Article 44.2811, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
4 amended to read as follows:

Art. 44.2811. RECORDS 5 RELATING TO CERTAIN [CHILDREN CONVICTED OF ] FINE-ONLY MISDEMEANORS COMMITTED BY A CHILD. [All 6 7 records and files and information stored by electronic means or otherwise, from which a record or file could be generated, relating 8 9 to a child who is convicted of and has satisfied the judgment for a 10 fine-only misdemeanor offense other than a traffic offense are 11 confidential and may not be disclosed to the public except as 12 provided under Article 45.0217(b).] All records and files and information stored by electronic means or otherwise, from which a 13 14 record or file could be generated, relating to a criminal case [child\_whose\_conviction] for a fine-only misdemeanor, other than a 15 traffic offense, that is committed by a child and that is appealed 16 17 [affirmed] are confidential [upon satisfaction of the judgment] and may not be disclosed to the public except as provided under Article 18 45.0217(b). 19

20 SECTION 2. The heading to Article 45.0217, Code of Criminal 21 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

22 Art. 45.0217. CONFIDENTIAL RECORDS RELATED TO <u>CHARGES</u> 23 AGAINST OR THE CONVICTION OF A CHILD.

SECTION 3. Article 45.0217(a), Code of Criminal Procedure,
is amended to read as follows:

(a) Except as provided by Article 15.27 and Subsection (b),
all records and files, including those held by law enforcement, and
information stored by electronic means or otherwise, from which a
record or file could be generated, relating to a child who is

1 <u>charged with, is</u> convicted of, is found not guilty of, had a charge 2 <u>dismissed for, or is granted deferred disposition</u> [and has 3 satisfied the judgment] for a fine-only misdemeanor offense other 4 than a traffic offense are confidential and may not be disclosed to 5 the public.

6 SECTION 4. Section 58.00711, Family Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 58.00711. RECORDS RELATING TO CHILDREN CHARGED WITH OR 9 CONVICTED OF FINE-ONLY MISDEMEANORS. Except as provided by Article 10 45.0217(b), Code of Criminal Procedure, all records and files and 11 information stored by electronic means or otherwise, from which a 12 record or file could be generated, relating to a child who is charged with, is convicted of, is found not guilty of, had a charge 13 14 dismissed for, or is granted deferred disposition [and has 15 satisfied-the judgment] for a fine-only misdemeanor offense other 16 than a traffic offense are confidential and may not be disclosed to 17 the public.

18 SECTION 5. Articles 44.2811 and 45.0217, Code of Criminal 19 Procedure, and Section 58.00711, Family Code, as amended by this 20 Act, apply to an offense committed before, on, or after the 21 effective date of this Act.
