10 (2) obtain a royalty, license right, or other

Amend H.B. 2472 by adding the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

SECTION \_\_. Sec. 2054.0401. Additional Powers and Duties of the Internal Auditor. The Internal auditor shall:

- (1) meaningfully consult with the State Auditor and Comptroller to determine the best practices in contracting for the Department;
- (2) examine any conflicts of interest that might interfere with the decision-making of the Department;
- (3) examine any conflicts of interest and management practices of any board or commissioners that oversee the operation of the Department;
- (4) examine the actions or any conflicts of interest with any foundation that works in conjunction with the operations of the Department;
- (5) examine the any existing or prior department catalog purchase or purchasing agreement for compliance with state policy on best contract management practices;
- (6) make a report to the legislature and State Auditor's Office about the current status implementing policies and management practices that exemplify open and transparent government;
- (7) take any other action related to implementing an open government policy or recommendation.
