| 5 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 6 | SECTION 1. Chapter 15, Water Code, is amended by adding |
| 7 | Subchapter G to read as follows: |
| 8 | SUBCHAPTER G. STATE WATER IMPLEMENTATION FUND FOR TEXAS |
| 9 | Sec. 15.431. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter: |

- 12 (2) "Fund" means the state water implementation fund
- 13 for Texas.
- Sec. 15.432. STATE WATER IMPLEMENTATION FUND FOR TEXAS. 14
- (a) The state water implementation fund for Texas is a special fund 15
- outside the state treasury to be administered without further 16
- appropriation by the board under this subchapter and rules adopted 17
- by the board under this subchapter. 18
- 19 (b) The fund consists of:
- (1) money transferred or deposited to the credit of 20
- 21 the fund by law;
- 22 (2) the proceeds of any fee or tax imposed by this
- 23 state that the legislature by statute dedicates for deposit to the
- 24 credit of the fund;

- 1 (3) any other revenue that the legislature by statute
- 2 dedicates for deposit to the credit of the fund; and
- 3 (4) interest earned on the balance of the fund.
- 4 Sec. 15.433. USE OF FUND. (a) The board may use money in
- 5 the fund only to provide financing for:
- 6 (1) projects included in the state water plan that are
- 7 authorized under Subchapter Q or R of this chapter, Subchapter E,
- 8 Chapter 16, or Subchapter J or K, Chapter 17, including water
- 9 conservation or reuse projects designed to reduce the need for this
- 10 state or political subdivisions of this state to develop additional
- 11 water resources; or
- 12 (2) education projects developed or approved by the
- 13 board that are related to the development of water resources, the
- 14 conservation of existing water resources, or water reuse.
- 15 (b) Not less than 20 percent of the money from the fund used
- 16 by the board in any state fiscal biennium must be used to finance
- 17 projects described by Subsection (a) for water conservation or
- 18 reuse or education.
- 19 (c) The board shall undertake to use money from the fund in
- 20 an amount sufficient to provide adequate financing for projects
- 21 described by Subsection (a) in each regional water planning area in
- 22 this state. The board shall prioritize projects in each regional
- 23 water planning area for purposes of this subsection.
- Sec. 15.434. TRANSFERS TO OTHER ACCOUNTS OR FUNDS. The
- 25 board may direct the comptroller to transfer amounts from the fund
- 26 to the credit of:
- 27 (1) the water infrastructure fund to be used for the

- 1 purposes provided by Section 15.433 related to projects included in
- 2 the state water plan that are authorized under Subchapter Q;
- 3 (2) the rural water assistance fund to be used for the
- 4 purposes provided by Section 15.433 related to projects included in
- 5 the state water plan that are authorized under Subchapter R;
- 6 (3) the Texas Water Development Fund II state
- 7 participation account to be used for the purposes provided by
- 8 Section 15.433 related to projects included in the state water plan
- 9 that are authorized under Subchapter E, Chapter 16;
- 10 (4) the agricultural water conservation fund to be
- 11 used for the purposes provided by Section 15.433 related to
- 12 projects included in the state water plan that are authorized under
- 13 Subchapter J, Chapter 17; or
- 14 (5) the Texas Water Development Fund II economically
- 15 distressed areas program account to be used for the purposes
- 16 provided by Section 15.433 related to projects included in the
- 17 state water plan that are authorized under Subchapter K, Chapter
- 18 17.
- 19 Sec. 15.435. ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (a) The State Water
- 20 Implementation Fund for Texas Advisory Committee is composed of
- 21 members appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives,
- 22 the lieutenant governor, and the governor.
- 23 (b) The advisory committee shall submit recommendations to
- 24 the board regarding the use of money in the fund for use by the board
- 25 in adopting rules under Section 15.436.
- Sec. 15.436. RULES. (a) The board shall adopt rules
- 27 providing for the use of money in the fund consistent with this

- 1 subchapter, including rules:
- 2 (1) establishing standards for the eligibility of
- 3 water conservation and reuse and education projects for financing
- 4 under Sections 15.433(a) and (b); and
- 5 (2) specifying the manner for prioritizing projects
- 6 for purposes of Section 15.433(c).
- 7 (b) The board shall give appropriate consideration to the
- 8 recommendations of the advisory committee before adopting rules
- 9 under this section.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 15.973(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (b) The fund consists of:
- 13 (1) appropriations from the legislature;
- 14 (2) any other fees or sources of revenue that the
- 15 legislature may dedicate for deposit to the fund;
- 16 (3) repayments of loans made from the fund;
- 17 (4) interest earned on money credited to the fund;
- 18 (5) depository interest allocable to the fund;
- 19 (6) money from gifts, grants, or donations to the
- 20 fund;
- 21 (7) money from revenue bonds or other sources
- 22 designated by the board; [and]
- 23 (8) proceeds from the sale of political subdivision
- 24 bonds or obligations held in the fund and not otherwise pledged to
- 25 the discharge, repayment, or redemption of revenue bonds or other
- 26 bonds, the proceeds of which were placed in the fund; and
- 27 (9) money transferred from the state water

- 1 implementation fund for Texas as authorized by Section 15.434.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 15.993, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 Sec. 15.993. FUND. The rural water assistance fund is a
- 5 special fund in the state treasury. The fund consists of:
- 6 (1) money directly appropriated to the board for a
- 7 purpose of the fund;
- 8 (2) repayment of principal and interest from loans
- 9 made from the fund not otherwise needed as a source of revenue
- 10 pursuant to Section 17.9615(b);
- 11 (3) money transferred by the board from any sources
- 12 available;
- 13 (4) interest earned on the investment of money in the
- 14 fund and depository interest allocable to the fund;
- 15 (5) money transferred to the fund from the water
- 16 assistance fund in accordance with Section 15.011(b), including
- 17 proceeds from the sale of political subdivision bonds by the board
- 18 to the Texas Water Resources Finance Authority that are deposited
- 19 in the water assistance fund as provided by Section 17.0871;
- 20 (6) money from gifts, grants, or donations to the
- 21 fund;
- 22 (6-a) money transferred from the state water
- 23 <u>implementation fund for Texas as authorized by Section 15.434;</u> and
- 24 (7) any other fees or sources of revenue that the
- 25 legislature may dedicate for deposit to the fund.
- SECTION 4. Section 17.895, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 27 follows:

- 1 Sec. 17.895. SOURCES OF ASSETS. The fund is composed of:
- 2 (1) money and assets, including bond proceeds,
- 3 attributable to the bonds;
- 4 (2) investment income earned on money on deposit in
- 5 the fund and depository interest earned on money on deposit in the
- 6 state treasury;
- 7 (3) money appropriated by the legislature;
- 8 (4) repayments of principal and interest on loans made
- 9 under this subchapter;
- 10 (5) administrative fees charged by the board under the
- 11 bond program;
- 12 (5-a) money transferred from the state water
- 13 implementation fund for Texas as authorized by Section 15.434; and
- 14 (6) any other funds, regardless of their source, that
- 15 the board directs be deposited to the credit of the fund.
- SECTION 5. Section 17.957(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 (b) The state participation account is composed of:
- 19 (1) money and assets attributable to water financial
- 20 assistance bonds designated by the board as issued for projects
- 21 described in Section 16.131;
- 22 (2) money from the sale, transfer, or lease of a
- 23 project described in Subdivision (1) that was acquired,
- 24 constructed, reconstructed, developed, or enlarged with money from
- 25 the state participation account;
- 26 (3) payments received under a bond enhancement
- 27 agreement with respect to water financial assistance bonds

- 1 designated by the board as issued for projects described in Section
- 2 16.131;
- 3 (4) investment income earned on money on deposit in
- 4 the state participation account;
- 5 (4-a) money transferred from the state water
- 6 implementation fund for Texas as authorized by Section 15.434; and
- 7 (5) any other funds, regardless of their source, that
- 8 the board directs be deposited to the credit of the state
- 9 participation account.
- SECTION 6. Section 17.958(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (b) The economically distressed areas program account is
- 13 composed of:
- 14 (1) money and assets attributable to water financial
- 15 assistance bonds designated by the board as issued for projects
- 16 described in Subchapter K;
- 17 (2) money provided by the federal government, the
- 18 state, political subdivisions, and private entities for the purpose
- 19 of paying debt service on water financial assistance bonds issued
- 20 for purposes provided by Subchapter K;
- 21 (3) payments received under a bond enhancement
- 22 agreement with respect to water financial assistance bonds
- 23 designated by the board as issued for purposes provided by
- 24 Subchapter K;
- 25 (4) investment income earned on money on deposit in
- 26 the economically distressed areas program account;
- 27 (4-a) money transferred from the state water

- 1 implementation fund for Texas as authorized by Section 15.434; and
- 2 (5) any other funds, regardless of their source, that
- 3 the board directs be deposited to the credit of the economically
- 4 distressed areas program account.
- 5 SECTION 7. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 6 of this Act, the speaker of the house of representatives, the
- 7 lieutenant governor, and the governor shall appoint the initial
- 8 members of the State Water Implementation Fund for Texas Advisory
- 9 Committee created under Section 15.435, Water Code, as added by
- 10 this Act.
- SECTION 8. Not later than December 1, 2013, the Texas Water
- 12 Development Board shall adopt rules under Section 15.436, Water
- 13 Code, as added by this Act.
- 14 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
