13	42.12, shall include the following information in the person's
14	profile for the site and shall ensure the information is viewable by
15	all visitors of the site:
16	(1) an indication that the person is a sex offender;
17	(2) the type of offense for which the person is subject
18	to registration under this chapter and the city and county in which
19	the person was convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication for

21	(3) the person's full name, date of birth, sex, race,
22	height, weight, eye color, and hair color; and
23	(4) the address at which the person resides or intends
24	to reside or, if the person does not reside or intend to reside at a

## physical address, a detailed description of each geographical location at which the person resides or intends to reside.

3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act in amending 4 Chapter 62, Code of Criminal Procedure, applies to any person who, 5 on or after the effective date of this Act, is subject to 6 registration under that chapter, regardless of whether the offense 7 for which the person is subject to registration was committed 8 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
