## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's student
- 3 success-based funding recommendations for certain public
- 4 institutions of higher education.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 61.0593(e), Education Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (e) Notwithstanding Subsection (d):
- 9 (1) not more than 25  $[\frac{10}{10}]$  percent of the total amount
- 10 of general revenue appropriations of base funds for undergraduate
- 11 education recommended by the board for all institutions to which
- 12 Subsection (d) applies for a state fiscal biennium may be based on
- 13 student success measures; and
- 14 (2) the board's recommendation for base funding for
- 15 undergraduate education based on student success measures does not
- 16 reduce or otherwise affect funding recommendations for graduate
- 17 education.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
