- 2 relating to suspension of payment of certain income benefits under
- 3 the workers' compensation system for failure to submit to a
- 4 designated doctor examination.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 408.0041(j), Labor Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (j) An employee is not entitled to [temporary] income
- 9 benefits, and an insurance carrier is authorized to suspend the
- 10 payment of [temporary] income benefits, during and for a period in
- 11 which the employee fails to submit to an examination required by
- 12 Subsection (a) or (f) unless the commissioner determines that the
- 13 employee had good cause for the failure to submit to the
- 14 examination. The commissioner may order [temporary] income
- 15 benefits to be paid for the period for which the commissioner
- 16 determined that the employee had good cause. The commissioner by
- 17 rule shall ensure that:
- 18 (1) an employee receives reasonable notice of an
- 19 examination and the insurance carrier's basis for suspension; and
- 20 (2) the employee is provided a reasonable opportunity
- 21 to reschedule an examination for good cause.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies to a suspension of payment of
- 23 income benefits authorized under Section 408.0041(j), Labor Code,
- 24 as amended by this Act, on or after the effective date of this Act.

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- 1 A suspension of payment of income benefits authorized before the
- 2 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the
- 3 time of the suspension of payment of income benefits, and the former
- 4 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
