H.B. No. 2027

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the amount of unclaimed lottery prize money to be
- 3 deposited in the fund for veterans' assistance.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 466.408(b), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) If a claim is not made for prize money on or before the
- 8 180th day after the date on which the winner was selected, the prize
- 9 money shall be used in the following order of priority:
- 10 (1) subject to legislative appropriation, not more
- 11 than \$20 million in prize money each year may be deposited to or
- 12 appropriated from the $[{\tt Texas}]$ Department of ${\tt State}$ Health ${\tt Services}$
- 13 state-owned multicategorical teaching hospital account, which is
- 14 an account in the general revenue fund;
- 15 (2) not more than \$5 million in prize money each year
- 16 may be appropriated to the Health and Human Services Commission and
- 17 shall be used to support the provision of inpatient hospital
- 18 services in hospitals located in the 15 counties that comprise the
- 19 Texas-Mexico border area, with payment for those services to be not
- 20 less than the amount established under the Tax Equity and Fiscal
- 21 Responsibility Act of 1982 (TEFRA) cost reimbursement methodology
- 22 for the hospital providing the services;
- 23 (3) <u>in each state fiscal year,</u> [the remaining amount,
- 24 not to exceed] \$5 million in prize money [in each state fiscal year

- 1 less any amount deposited in the fund in that year attributable to
- 2 the lottery game operated under Section 466.027, shall be
- 3 deposited to the fund for veterans' assistance; and
- 4 (4) all prize money subject to this section and not
- 5 appropriated or deposited as provided by Subdivision (1), (2), or
- 6 (3) [from the Texas Department of Health state-owned
- 7 multicategorical teaching hospital account, not appropriated to
- 8 the Health and Human Services Commission for the purpose specified
- 9 in Subdivision (2), and not deposited under Subdivision (3), shall
- 10 be deposited in the general revenue fund and may be appropriated for
- 11 any purpose as determined by the legislature, including the
- 12 provision of indigent health care services as specified in Chapter
- 13 61, Health and Safety Code.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 15 466.408(b), Government Code, applies only to a prize for which the
- 16 winner is selected on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 17 prize for which the winner was selected before that date is governed
- 18 by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of
- 19 this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
