A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the early voting period for the general primary and
- 3 general elections for state and county officers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 85.001(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The period for early voting by personal appearance
- 8 begins on the $\underline{10th}$ [$\underline{17th}$] day before election day and continues
- 9 through the fourth day before election day, except as otherwise
- 10 provided by this section.
- SECTION 2. Sections 85.005(a), (b), and (c), Election Code,
- 12 are amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), in an election in
- 14 which a county clerk or city secretary is the early voting clerk
- under Section 83.002 or 83.005, early voting by personal appearance
- 16 at the main early voting polling place shall be conducted on each
- 17 weekday and Saturday [the weekdays] of the early voting period and
- 18 during the hours that the county clerk's or city secretary's main
- 19 business office is regularly open for business.
- 20 (b) In an election to which Subsection (a) does not apply,
- 21 early voting by personal appearance at the main early voting
- 22 polling place shall be conducted at least eight hours each weekday
- 23 and Saturday of the early voting period that is not a legal state
- 24 holiday unless the territory covered by the election has fewer than

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- 1 1,000 registered voters. In that case, the voting shall be
- 2 conducted at least three hours each day. The authority ordering the
- 3 election, or the county clerk if that person is the early voting
- 4 clerk, shall determine which hours the voting is to be conducted.
- 5 (c) In a county with a population of 100,000 or more, the
- 6 voting in a primary election or the general election for state and
- 7 county officers shall be conducted at the main early voting polling
- 8 place for at least 12 hours on each weekday and Saturday [of the
- 9 last week] of the early voting period, and the voting in a special
- 10 election ordered by the governor shall be conducted at the main
- 11 early voting polling place for at least 12 hours on each of the last
- 12 two days of the early voting period. Voting shall be conducted in
- 13 accordance with this subsection in those elections in a county with
- 14 a population under 100,000 on receipt by the early voting clerk of a
- 15 written request for the extended hours submitted by at least 50 [15]
- 16 registered voters of the county. The request must be submitted in
- 17 time to enable compliance with Section 85.067.
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 85.006, Election Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- Sec. 85.006. VOTING ON [SATURDAY OR] SUNDAY. (a) Except as
- 21 provided by Subsection (b), the authority ordering an election may
- 22 order early voting by personal appearance at the main early voting
- 23 polling place to be conducted on Sunday [one or more Saturdays or
- 24 Sundays] during the early voting period.
- 25 (b) In an election in which a county clerk or city secretary
- 26 is the early voting clerk under Section 83.002 or 83.005, only the
- 27 early voting clerk may order voting on a [Saturday or] Sunday. The

- 1 clerk must do so by written order.
- 2 (c) The authority ordering voting on a [Saturday or] Sunday
- 3 shall determine the hours during which voting is to be conducted.
- 4 (d) The authority authorized to order early voting on a

[Saturday or] Sunday under Subsection (a) or (b) shall order the

- 6 voting under the applicable subsection on receipt of a written
- 7 request submitted by at least $\underline{50}$ [$\underline{15}$] registered voters of the
- 8 territory covered by the election. The request must be submitted in
- 9 time to enable compliance with Section 85.007. [The authority is
- 10 not required to order the voting on a particular date specified by
- 11 the request but shall order the voting on at least one Saturday if a
- 12 Saturday is requested and on at least one Sunday if a Sunday is
- 13 requested.

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- 14 (e) In a primary election or the general election for state
- 15 and county officers in a county with a population of 100,000 or
- 16 more, the early voting clerk shall order personal appearance voting
- 17 at the main early voting polling place to be conducted for at least
- 18 [$\frac{12 \text{ hours on the last Saturday and for at least}}{2}$] five hours on the
- 19 [last] Sunday during [of] the early voting period. The early voting
- $20\,$ clerk shall order voting to be conducted at those times in those
- 21 elections in a county with a population under 100,000 on receipt of
- 22 a written request for those hours submitted by at least 50 [15]
- 23 registered voters of the county. The request must be submitted in
- 24 time to enable compliance with Section 85.007. This subsection
- 25 supersedes any provision of this subchapter to the extent of any
- 26 conflict.
- SECTION 4. Sections 85.007(a) and (b), Election Code, are

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- 1 amended to read as follows:
- 2 (a) The election order and the election notice must state:
- 3 (1) the date that early voting will begin if under
- 4 Section 85.001(d) the early voting period is to begin later than the
- 5 prescribed date;
- 6 (2) the regular dates and hours that voting will be
- 7 conducted under Section 85.005(b); and
- 8 (3) the dates and hours that voting on [Saturday or]
- 9 Sunday is ordered to be conducted under Section 85.006(a).
- 10 (b) The early voting clerk shall post notice for each
- 11 election stating the dates and hours that voting on a [Saturday or]
- 12 Sunday is ordered to be conducted under Section 85.006(b).
- SECTION 5. Sections 85.001(b) and (c), Election Code, are
- 14 repealed.
- 15 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
