## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the establishment of the Alamo Museum District
- 3 Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "commission" means the
- 6 Alamo Museum District Commission.
- 7 SECTION 2. COMMISSION CREATED; COMPOSITION. (a) The Alamo
- 8 Museum District Commission is created.
- 9 (b) The commission is composed of 11 members.
- 10 (c) Not later than December 1, 2013, the mayor of San
- 11 Antonio, the county judge of Bexar County, the governor, the
- 12 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 13 representatives shall jointly appoint a member to the commission
- 14 from a nonprofit organization and appoint additional members to the
- 15 commission as follows:
- 16 (1) the mayor of San Antonio shall appoint two
- 17 members, one of whom must be an area property holder;
- 18 (2) the county judge of Bexar County shall appoint two
- 19 members, one of whom must be a historian;
- 20 (3) the governor shall appoint two members, one of
- 21 whom must be a historical preservationist;
- 22 (4) the lieutenant governor shall appoint two members,
- 23 one of whom must be a civil engineer; and
- 24 (5) the speaker of the house of representatives shall

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- 1 appoint two members, one of whom must be a museum expert.
- 2 (d) The original appointing authority shall fill a vacancy
- 3 on the commission.
- 4 SECTION 3. PRESIDING OFFICER. The member appointed jointly
- 5 by the appointing authorities who is a representative of a
- 6 nonprofit organization serves as the presiding officer of the
- 7 commission.
- 8 SECTION 4. MEETINGS. The commission shall hold at least
- 9 four public meetings.
- 10 SECTION 5. DUTIES; REPORT. (a) The commission shall develop
- 11 a plan to establish an Alamo Museum District designed to further
- 12 honor the Alamo as a natural treasure, reclaim its original
- 13 footprint, and make this state and San Antonio a global cultural
- 14 destination.
- 15 (b) Not later than December 1, 2014, the commission shall
- 16 report to the legislature the plan developed under Subsection (a)
- 17 of this section.
- 18 SECTION 6. EXPIRATION. This Act expires and the commission
- 19 is abolished January 1, 2015.
- 20 SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 21 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 22 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 23 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 24 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
