## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to insurers as proper parties to certain actions for
- 3 damages.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 17, Civil Practice and
- 6 Remedies Code, is amended by adding Section 17.006 to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Sec. 17.006. SUIT FOR DAMAGES AGAINST INSURED DEFENDANT.
- 9 In a suit for recovery of damages in which a defendant in the suit is
- 10 an insured under a policy of liability insurance that may provide
- 11 coverage for the damages, the insurer who issued the policy,
- 12 <u>including a county mutual insurance company</u>, a Lloyd's plan
- 13 <u>insurer</u>, a surplus lines insurer, or a reciprocal or interinsurance
- 14 exchange, is a proper party to the suit.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an action commenced on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An action commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law applicable to the action immediately before the
- 19 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 20 that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
