A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 42, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter J to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER J. TAXPAYER SAVINGS GRANTS
8	Sec. 42.501. TAXPAYER SAVINGS GRANT PROGRAM. (a) In this
9	section:
10	(1) "Eligible student" means a school-age child who
11	resides in the state and who:
12	(A) is entering kindergarten or first grade; or
13	(B) attended a public school for all of the
14	academic year immediately preceding initial participation in the
15	program, or is a prior participant in the program.
16	(b) A parent or legal guardian of an eligible student who
17	agrees to accept reimbursement in an amount that is less than the
18	state average maintenance and operations expenditures per student
19	may receive reimbursement from the state for the tuition paid for
20	the enrollment of the eligible student at a private school in an
21	<pre>amount that is the lesser of:</pre>
22	(1) the tuition paid; or
23	(2) 60 percent of the state average maintenance and
24	operations expenditures per student.

- 1 (c) Money from the available school fund and federal funds
- 2 may not be used for reimbursement under this section.
- 3 (d) Private schools that parents voluntarily choose to
- 4 attend, with or without governmental assistance, will not be
- 5 required to comply with any state law or regulation governing its
- 6 educational program that was not in effect on January 1, 2013."
- 7 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable, but not later than the
- 8 45th day after the effective date of this Act, the comptroller, in
- 9 coordination with the commissioner of education, shall adopt rules
- 10 to implement the Taxpayer Savings Grant Program under Section
- 11 42.501, Education Code, as added by this Act, including rules to
- 12 prevent fraud in financial transactions under the program and to
- 13 determine the net savings resulting from implementation of the
- 14 program. Such regulations shall reconcile payments to all schools
- 15 within the same fiscal year, or one month after.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013, if it
- 17 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 18 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 19 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
- 20 date, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 21 legislation session.
