- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as Malorie's Law.
- 5 SECTION 2. Sec. 662.002, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
- - 7 Sec. 662.002. PURPOSE OF PROGRAM; CURRICULUM. (a) The
  - purpose of the motorcycle operator training and safety program is: 8
  - 9 (1) to make available to motorcycle operators:
- information relating to the operation of 10 (A)
- 11 motorcycles; and

- 12 (B) courses in knowledge, skills, and safety
- 13 relating to the operation of motorcycles; and
- 14 (2) to provide information to the public on sharing
- roadways with motorcycles. 15
- 16 (b) The program shall:
- 17 (1) contain material regarding operating a motorcycle
- while carrying a passenger, and 18
- may include curricula developed by the Motorcycle 19
- 20 Safety Foundation.
- 21 SECTION 3. Section 545.416, Transportation Code, is amended
- 22 to read as follows:
- Sec. 545.416. RIDING ON MOTORCYCLE. (a) An operator of a 23
- 24 motorcycle shall ride on the permanent and regular seat attached to

- 1 the motorcycle.
- 2 (b) An operator may not carry another person on the
- 3 motorcycle, and a person who is not operating the motorcycle may not
- 4 ride on the motorcycle, unless the motorcycle is designed to carry
- 5 more than one person.
- 6 (c) If the motorcycle is designed to carry more than one
- 7 person, a passenger may ride only on the permanent and regular seat,
- 8 if designed for two persons, or on another seat firmly attached to
- 9 the motorcycle behind or to the side of the operator.
- 10 (d) If a motorcycle is designed to carry more than one
- 11 person, the motorcycle must be equipped with foot rests and
- 12 <u>handholds for use by a passenger on the motorcycle.</u>
- 13  $\frac{d}{d}$  (e) Except as provided by Subsection (f), an operator
- 14 may not carry another person on a motorcycle unless the other person
- 15 is at least five years of age. An offense under this subsection is a
- 16 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 or more than
- 17 \$200. It is a defense to prosecution under this subsection that the
- 18 operator was operating the motorcycle in an emergency or for a law
- 19 enforcement purpose.
- [( $\frac{e}{}$ )] ( $\frac{f}{}$ ) Subsection ( $\frac{d}{}$ )( $\frac{e}{}$ ) does not prohibit an operator
- 21 from carrying on a motorcycle a person younger than five years of
- 22 age who is seated in a sidecar attached to the motorcycle.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect on September 1, 2013.
