This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 8 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013. 9 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 10 proposition: "The constitutional amendment eliminating an 11 obsolete requirement for a State Medical Education Board and a 12 State Medical Education Fund, neither of which is operational."
