8	Sec. 544.551. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "consumer
9	inquiry" has the meaning assigned by Section 551.113 for "customer
10	inquiry."
11	Sec. 544.552. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only
12	to a standard fire, homeowners, or farm and ranch owners insurance
13	policy.
14	Sec. 544.553. PROHIBITION OF UNDERWRITING AND RATING
15	DECISIONS BASED ON CONSUMER INQUIRY. An insurer may not:
16	(1) use an underwriting guideline based solely on
17	whether a consumer inquiry has been made by or on behalf of the
18	applicant or insured; or
19	(2) charge a rate that is different from the rate
20	charged to other individuals for the same coverage or increase a
21	rate charged to an insured based solely on whether a consumer
22	inquiry has been made by or on behalf of the applicant or insured.
23	SECTION 2. The heading to Section 551.113, Insurance Code,
24	is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 551.113. DECLINATION, NONRENEWAL, OR CANCELLATION 1 PROHIBITED; CONSIDERATION OF CONSUMER INQUIRY [CERTAIN CLAIMS]. 2 SECTION 3. Section 551.113, Insurance Code, is amended by 3 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows: 4 5 (b-1) An insurer may not consider a customer inquiry as a basis for nonrenewal or cancellation of an insurance policy. 6 7 SECTION 4. This Act applies only to an insurance policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after the 8 effective date of this Act. A policy delivered, issued for 9 delivery, or renewed before the effective date of this Act is 10 governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective 11 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that 12 13 purpose.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
