13	filing of documents in courts of this state.
14	(3) "Electronic filing transaction" means the
15	simultaneous electronic filing of one or more documents related to
16	a proceeding before a court in this state.
17	(4) "Local government" means a county or municipality.
18	(b) The office as authorized by supreme court rule or order
19	may implement an electronic filing system for use in the courts of
20	this state.
21	(c) A local government or appellate court that uses the
22	electronic filing system may charge a fee of \$2 for each electronic
23	filing transaction if:
24	(1) the fee is necessary to recover the actual system

operating costs directly and reasonably incurred by the local 1 2 government or appellate court to: (A) accept electronic payment methods; or 3 4 (B) interface with other technology information 5 systems; (2) the fee does not include an amount to recover local 6 7 government or appellate court employee costs; 8 (3) the local government or appellate court approves the fee using the local government or appellate court's standard 9 approval process for fee increases; and 10 (4) the chief financial officer of the local 11 12 government or appellate court annually certifies to the office on a form prescribed by the office that the amount of the fee is 13 14 necessary to recover the actual system operating costs incurred by 15 the local government or appellate court. 16 (d) A local government or appellate court that uses the 17 electronic filing system may accept electronic payment methods, including payments made with credit and debit cards. 18
