## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize online poker
- 2 gaming regulated under federal law.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 47(a), Article III, Texas Constitution,
- 5 is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The Legislature shall pass laws prohibiting lotteries
- 7 and gift enterprises in this State other than those authorized by
- 8 Subsections (b), (d), and (e) of this section and Section 47a of
- 9 this article.
- 10 SECTION 2. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 11 adding Section 47a to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 47a. (a) If a federal law is enacted that establishes
- 13 a licensing program to license the operation of online poker
- 14 facilities and that allows any state the option of applying the law
- 15 to authorize licensed online poker facilities to accept bets for
- 16 online poker games from individuals located in the state:
- 17 (1) this state is considered to have opted into the
- 18 application of the law; and
- 19 (2) the operation of any Internet gambling facility in
- 20 this state is subject to the provisions of the federal law.
- 21 (b) Any state law that conflicts with the federal law
- 22 described by Subsection (a) of this section is preempted and
- 23 superseded by the federal law.
- 24 (c) In the absence of enabling legislation to implement

- 1 Subsection (a) of this section, the authority of this state to
- 2 operate lotteries under Section 47(e) of this article includes the
- 3 authority of the state agency that operates state lotteries to
- 4 adopt rules to implement Subsection (a) of this section, and the
- 5 state agency shall adopt rules necessary to implement online poker
- 6 in accordance with Subsection (a) of this section and the
- 7 <u>applicable federal law.</u>
- 8 (d) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Bet" means an agreement to win or lose something
- 10 of value solely or partially by chance.
- 11 (2) "Internet gambling facility" means an Internet
- 12 website, or similar communications facility, in which
- 13 transmissions may cross any state's boundaries and through which a
- 14 bet is initiated, received, or otherwise made and is transmitted by
- 15 telephone, Internet, satellite, or other wire or wireless
- 16 communication facility, service, or medium. The term includes an
- 17 online poker facility that is not operated under a license issued by
- 18 a licensing program established under federal law.
- 19 (3) "Licensed online poker facility" means an online
- 20 poker facility operating under a license issued and authorized by a
- 21 licensing program established under federal law.
- 22 <u>(4) "Online poker" means any card game that for</u>
- 23 consideration offers players of the game the opportunity to:
- 24 (A) place a bet on cards dealt out of a common
- 25 <u>deck of cards to two or more players; and</u>
- 26 (B) compete against each other and not against
- 27 the person operating the game.

- 1 (5) "Online poker facility" means an Internet gambling
- 2 facility through which a bet for a game, hand, tournament, or other
- 3 contest of online poker is initiated, received, or otherwise made.
- 4 (6) "Operate" or "operation" means to carry on,
- 5 maintain, or expose for play.
- 6 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 7 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.
- 8 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 9 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize online
- 10 poker gaming regulated under federal law."
