Pursuant to a notice posted in accordance with Senate Rule 11.10 and 11.18, a public hearing of the Senate Committee on Higher Education was held on Wednesday, April 24, 2013, in the Capitol Extension, Room E1.012, at Austin, Texas.

The chair laid out SB 1525 and recognized the author, Senator Zaffirini, to explain the bill.

Senator Zaffirini moved that SB 1525 be reported favorably to the Senate with the recommendation that it do pass and be printed. Senator Birdwell moved adoption of the minutes from the previous hearing held on April 17, 2013; without objection, it was so ordered.

The chair laid out SB 1258 and recognized Senator Zaffirini, in the absence of the author, to explain the bill.

Senator West sent up a committee substitute; the chair recognized Senator Hinojosa to explain the difference between the committee substitute and the senate bill as filed.

Senator Zaffirini moved adoption of the committee substitute; without objection, it was so ordered.

Senator Zaffirini moved that SB 1258 do not pass but that CSSB 1258 be reported back to the Senate with the recommendation that it do pass and be printed. The motion carried with a record vote of 5 ayes, 0 nays, 0 present not voting, and 2 absent.
