Relating to the hours of sale for liquor.

**SB 241** Carona  
Relating to the authority of an electric customer to choose not to have a utility's advanced meter.

**SB 451** Carona  
Relating to production requirements for holders of winery permits.

**SB 861** Davis  
Relating to requiring certain notices to be posted on the premises of certain alcoholic beverage retailers.

**SB 870** Van de Putte | et al.  
Relating to marketing items provided by manufacturers, wholesalers, and distributors of alcoholic beverages to retailers or consumers.

**SB 883** Van de Putte  
Relating to promotional items provided by manufacturers, wholesalers, and distributors of alcoholic beverages to retailers.

**SB 950** Carona  
Relating to requiring certain alcoholic beverage permittees to be the primary source of supply for certain alcoholic beverages.

**SB 962** Carona  
Relating to the approval of certain alcoholic beverages by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission.
