SJR 62 Hinojosa Proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize the creation of emergency and disaster response districts; providing authority to impose a tax and issue bonds.

HB 826 Harless SP: Eltife Relating to the definitions of certain terms for purposes of the ad valorem taxation of certain dealer's heavy equipment inventory.

HB 1348Menéndez | et al.SP: UrestiRelating to the taxation of certain tangible personal property locatedinside a defense base development authority.

HB 1903Eiland | et al.SP: WilliamsRelating to the allocation of amounts deposited into the oyster salesaccount and the abolishment of the oyster advisory committee.

HB 1913 Bohac | et al. SP: Williams
Relating to the waiver of penalties and interest on certain delinquent ad
valorem taxes.
