A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the creation of a task force to conduct a study and
- 3 develop recommendations on the efficacy of the continuation of
- 4 daylight saving time in this state.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. TEXAS TASK FORCE ON DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME. (a)
- 7 The Texas Task Force on Daylight Saving Time is created.
- 8 (b) The task force shall study the efficacy of the
- 9 continuation of daylight saving time in this state.
- 10 (c) The task force is composed of the following seven
- 11 members:

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- 12 (1) one member appointed by the governor;
- 13 (2) one member appointed by the lieutenant governor;
- 14 (3) one member appointed by the speaker of the house of
- 15 representatives;
- 16 (4) one member appointed by the commissioner of
- 17 agriculture;
- 18 (5) one member appointed by the comptroller;
- 19 (6) one member appointed by the chair of the Railroad
- 20 Commission of Texas; and
- 21 (7) one member appointed by the chair of the Texas
- 22 Transportation Commission.
- 23 (d) The governor shall designate a member of the task force
- 24 to serve as presiding officer.

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- 1 (e) A member of the task force is not entitled to
- 2 compensation but is entitled to reimbursement for the member's
- 3 travel expenses as provided by Chapter 660, Government Code, and
- 4 the General Appropriations Act.
- 5 (f) The task force shall compile a detailed report of its
- 6 findings and recommendations and shall submit the report to the
- 7 governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 8 representatives not later than December 1, 2016. The report must
- 9 include a recommendation by the task force as to whether the
- 10 legislature should act to exempt the state from the provisions of
- 11 the Uniform Time Act of 1966 (15 U.S.C. Section 260a(a)) that
- 12 establish daylight saving time.
- 13 (g) The task force is not subject to Chapter 2110,
- 14 Government Code.
- 15 (h) The task force is abolished and this Act expires on
- 16 January 1, 2017.
- 17 SECTION 2. APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS. The members of the task
- 18 force shall be appointed to the Texas Task Force on Daylight Saving
- 19 Time, as required by this Act, as soon as practicable after the
- 20 effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 22 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 23 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 24 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 25 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
