8	INTERNET. (a) The commission shall make available to the public on
9	the commission's Internet website each financial statement filed
10	under this subchapter by the following persons:
11	(1) a member of the legislature;
12	(2) an executive or judicial officer elected in a

- 14 (3) a member of the State Board of Education.
- 15 <u>(b) The commission shall make a financial statement</u>
- 16 described in Subsection (a) available on the commission's Internet
- 17 website not later than the 10th business day after the date the
- 18 statement is filed.
- (c) The commission shall remove the home address of an
- 20 <u>individual from a financial statement filed by the individual under</u>
- 21 this subchapter before posting the statement on the commission's
- 22 Internet website under this section.
- 23 (d) Notwithstanding Section 572.032(c), the commission may
- 24 not remove a financial statement described in Subsection (a) from

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- 1 the commission's Internet website before the 10th anniversary of
- 2 the date the commission makes the statement available on the
- 3 <u>commission's Internet website.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 572.0321, Government Code, as added by
- 5 this Act, applies only to a financial statement filed under
- 6 Subchapter B, Chapter 572, Government Code, that is due on or after
- 7 September 1, 2015.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
