6 SECTION 1. Sections 63.202(f) and (g), Education Code, are

7 amended to read as follows:

8 (f) Notwithstanding the limitation provided by Subsection

(b), grants awarded under Subsection (c) for the state fiscal

10 biennium ending on August 31, 2017 [2013], and the fiscal biennium

11 ending on August 31, $\underline{2019}$ [$\underline{2015}$], by the Texas Higher Education

12 Coordinating Board shall be awarded to programs preparing students

13 for initial licensure as registered nurses or programs preparing

14 qualified faculty members with a master's or doctoral degree for

15 the program, including programs at two-year institutions of higher

16 education, four-year general academic teaching institutions,

17 health science centers, and independent or private institutions of

18 higher education, or to the nursing resource section established

19 under Section 105.002(b), Health and Safety Code. In awarding

20 grants under this subsection, the coordinating board may:

21 (1) give priority to institutions proposing to address

22 the shortage of registered nurses by promoting innovation in

23 education, recruitment, and retention of nursing students and

- 1 (2) award grants on a competitive basis;
- 2 (3) consider the availability of matching funds; and
- 3 (4) fund a study by the nursing resource section to 4 evaluate the competencies of clinical judgment and behaviors that
- 5 professional nursing students should possess at the time of
- 6 graduation.
- 7 (g) Subsection (f) and this subsection expire September 1,
- 8 2019 [2015].
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
