The term does not include a cause of action described by Section 406.033(a) or 408.001(b), Labor Code, against an employer 15 16 by an employee or the employee's surviving spouse or heir. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of 18 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date 19 20 of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the cause of action
