- 17 (b) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor,
- 18 except that an offense is a Class B misdemeanor if the person
- 19 violates a rule adopted under Section 411.062(d-1).
- 20 SECTION 3. (a) The director of the Department of Public
- 21 Safety shall adopt the rules required by Section 411.062(d-1),
- 22 Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than December 1,
- 23 2015.
- (b) The change in law made by this Act to Section 411.065,

H.B. No. 3628

- 1 Government Code, applies only to an offense committed on or after
- 2 December 1, 2015. An offense committed before that date is governed
- 3 by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this
- 4 Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 5 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before December
- 6 1, 2015, if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
