8	EXCEPTION FOR SERVICES PERFORMED BY CERTAIN <u>TRAINED</u> [BLIND]
9	INDIVIDUALS. (a) In this subtitle, "employment" does not include
10	service performed [by an individual who]:
11	(1) by an individual whose earning capacity is
12	impaired by age, physical impairment, developmental disability,
13	mental illness, or intellectual disability or injury [receives
14	rehabilitative work or paying work in the employ of a facility that:
15	[(A) is conducted to carry out a program of
16	rehabilitation for individuals whose earning capacity is impaired
17	by:
18	[(i)_age;
19	[(ii) physical impairment, other than
20	blindness; or
21	[(iii) mental deficiency or injury; or
22	[(B) provides paying work for individuals who ,
23	because of their impaired physical or mental capacity, cannot be
24	readily absorbed in the competitive labor market;

H.B. No. 3685 [(2) is blind] while the individual is in training at a 1 sheltered workshop or other facility operated by a charitable 2 3 organization under a rehabilitation program that includes: 4 an individual plan for employment as required (A) 5 by 29 U.S.C. Section 722, as amended by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (Pub. L. No. 113-128); 6 7 a timeline for completion of the training; (B) 8 and 9 (C) a planned employment outcome; or (2) by an individual who [(3)] receives work relief or 10 work training as a part of an unemployment work-relief or 11 12 work-training program assisted or financed in whole or in part by a federal agency, an agency of a state, a political subdivision of a 13 14 state, or an Indian tribe. 15 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a)(1) [(a)], in this subtitle "employment" includes service performed by an individual 16 17 whose earning capacity is impaired by age, physical impairment, developmental disability, mental illness, or intellectual 18 disability or injury, other than an individual compensated as 19 provided by Section 62.057, [who is blind] and who, after training, 20 is working for a sheltered workshop or other facility operated by a 21 charitable organization: 22 23 (1)temporarily while awaiting placement in a position 24 of employment in the competitive labor market; or permanently because the individual is unable to 25 (2) 26 compete in the competitive labor market. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016. 27
