A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the confidentiality of certain information regarding

- 3 procedures and substances used in the execution of a convict.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 552.1081 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.1081. EXCEPTION: CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN
- 8 INFORMATION REGARDING EXECUTION OF CONVICT. Information is
- 9 excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021 if it contains
- 10 identifying information under Article 43.14, Code of Criminal
- 11 Procedure, including that of:
- 12 (1) any person who participates in an execution
- 13 procedure, including a person who uses, supplies, or administers a
- 14 substance during the execution; and
- 15 (2) any person or entity that manufactures,
- 16 transports, tests, procures, compounds, prescribes, dispenses, or
- 17 provides a substance or supplies used in an execution.
- 18 SECTION 2. Article 43.14, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- 20 Art. 43.14. EXECUTION OF <u>CONVICT: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION</u>
- 21 [CONVICT]. (a) Whenever the sentence of death is pronounced
- 22 against a convict, the sentence shall be executed at any time after
- 23 the hour of 6 p.m. on the day set for the execution, by intravenous
- 24 injection of a substance or substances in a lethal quantity

- 1 sufficient to cause death and until such convict is dead, such
- 2 execution procedure to be determined and supervised by the director
- 3 of the correctional institutions division of the Texas Department
- 4 of Criminal Justice.
- 5 (b) The name, address, and other identifying information of
- 6 the following is confidential and excepted from disclosure under
- 7 <u>Section 552.021</u>, <u>Government Code</u>:
- 8 <u>(1) any person who participates in an execution</u>
- 9 procedure described by Subsection (a), including a person who uses,
- 10 supplies, or administers a substance during the execution; and
- 11 (2) any person or entity that manufactures,
- 12 transports, tests, procures, compounds, prescribes, dispenses, or
- 13 provides a substance or supplies used in an execution.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 15 a request for information that is received by a governmental body or
- 16 an officer for public information on or after the effective date of
- 17 this Act. A request for information that was received before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 19 date the request was received, and the former law is continued in
- 20 effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
