## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 applying to the Congress of the United States to call a convention
- 2 under Article V of the United States Constitution for the limited
- 3 purpose of proposing one or more amendments to the constitution to

- 7 WHEREAS, The drafters of the United States Constitution
- 8 empowered state legislatures to be guardians of liberty against
- 9 abuses of power by the federal government; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The federal government has abused its power by
- 11 creating a crushing national debt through improper and imprudent
- 12 spending; and
- WHEREAS, The federal government has abused its power by
- 14 invading the legitimate role of the states through the manipulative
- 15 process of federal mandates that are to a great extent unfunded; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The federal government has ceased to abide by a
- 17 proper interpretation of the United States Constitution; and
- 18 WHEREAS, It is the solemn duty of state legislatures to
- 19 protect the liberty of the people and of future generations by
- 20 proposing amendments to the United States Constitution that place
- 21 clear restraints on federal power; and
- WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution
- 23 authorizes the several state legislatures to restrict the power of
- 24 the federal government through the amendment process; and

1 WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution provides that on application of the legislatures of two-thirds of the 2 3 several states Congress shall call a convention for the purpose of proposing amendments to the constitution; now, therefore, be it 4 5 RESOLVED, That the 84th Texas Legislature apply to Congress to call a convention under Article V of the United States 6 Constitution for the limited purpose of proposing one or more 7 8 amendments to the constitution to impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, to limit the power and jurisdiction of the 9 federal government, and to limit the terms of office of federal 10 officials and members of Congress; and, be it further 11 12 RESOLVED, That, unless rescinded bу а succeeding legislature, this application by the 84th Texas Legislature 13 14 constitutes a continuing application in accordance with Article V 15 of the United States Constitution until at least two-thirds of the legislatures of the several states have applied to Congress to call 16 17 a convention for the limited purpose of proposing one or more amendments to the constitution to impose fiscal restraints on the 18 19 federal government, to limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and to limit the terms of office of federal 20 officials and members of Congress; and, be it further 21 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official 22 copies of this resolution to the president of the United States, to 23 24 the speaker of the House of Representatives and the president of the Senate of the Congress of the United States, and to all members of 25 the Texas delegation to Congress with the request that this
