## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, January 20, 2015, marked the 25th anniversary of
Black January, the event that signaled the beginning of the end of
Soviet rule in Azerbaijan; and

WHEREAS, On that day in 1990, 26,000 troops from the U.S.S.R. invaded Azerbaijan in response to a growing independence movement in the country, and the soldiers stormed the capital city of Baku in tanks and armored vehicles; despite the overwhelming show of force, Azerbaijanis kept up a courageous resistance to the invasion, continuing their fight into February; and

WHEREAS, According to Azerbaijani records, at least 170 Azeris were killed in the conflict, more than 320 went missing, over 700 were wounded, and some 800 people were arrested; although the Baku incursion caused terrible suffering and loss, it helped bring about change by strengthening support for independence among Azerbaijanis; and

16 WHEREAS, That dream became a reality on October 18, 1991, 17 when the parliament of Azerbaijan voted to restore the country's 18 independence, and later that year, the Soviet Union itself was 19 dissolved; and

20 WHEREAS, A quarter-century after Black January, the 21 determined response of Azerbaijanis to Soviet oppression remains an 22 inspiring example of the quest for freedom; now, therefore, be it
