4 in Harris County; and

5 WHEREAS, Representative Turner was first elected in 1988, and

6 over the course of his noteworthy tenure, he has worked tirelessly

7 to improve the lives of all citizens and to promote reform in

8 education, health care, human services, consumer rights, and

9 juvenile justice; along the way, he has earned renown for his

10 ability to build consensus and for his leadership in numerous

11 roles, including speaker pro tempore, an office he held from 2003 to

18 Board; additionally, he chairs both the Texas Legislative Black

19 Caucus and the Greater Houston Area Legislative Delegation; and

20 WHEREAS, Representative Turner has lent his expertise to a

21 host of committees related to fiscal matters, and he chaired the

22 House Criminal Justice Appropriations Committee and the House

23 Select Committee on Hurricane Ike Storm Devastation to the Texas

24 Gulf Coast; in addition, he has served on the House Calendars

- 1 Committee and the House Select Committee on Electric Generation
- 2 Capacity and Environmental Effects, among others; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Especially dedicated to the well-being of those who
- 4 are most vulnerable, Representative Turner authored the bill that
- 5 added 127,000 previously uninsured children to the Texas Children's
- 6 Health Insurance Program; he was named one of the "13 Big Voices for
- 7 Little Texans in 2013" by the Court Appointed Special Advocates
- 8 Association, and that same year, he was presented with the
- 9 Humanitarian Award at the national conference of Kappa Alpha Psi
- 10 Fraternity; moreover, he has been lauded by Texas Monthly magazine
- 11 and other publications and by such organizations as the NAACP, the
- 12 Texas Veterans Commission, the Texas Classroom Teachers
- 13 Association, Common Cause of Texas, the Texas Pediatric Society,
- 14 and the Texas Police Chiefs Association; and
- 15 WHEREAS, This proud native son of the Bayou City was
- 16 instrumental in the creation of the Houston Astros MLB Urban Youth
- 17 Baseball Academy, which provides free baseball and softball
- 18 instruction to youngsters at Sylvester Turner Park; he coordinates
- 19 the annual Acres Homes Juneteenth Parade, as well as a number of
- 20 other local events, and he has given generously of his time and
- 21 talents to the United Negro College Fund, the Acres Homes Citizens
- 22 Chamber of Commerce, and the Coalition for School Improvement; and
- WHEREAS, With deep roots in the Houston community, Sylvester
- 24 Turner became speaker of the student senate at the University of
- 25 Houston, and he went on to graduate from Harvard Law School; he
- 26 joined Fulbright and Jaworski before establishing his own firm,
- 27 Barnes and Turner, in 1983; while in private practice, he has also

- 1 served as an adjunct professor at the Thurgood Marshall School of
- 2 Law and as a lecturer for the South Texas College of Law and the
- 3 University of Houston Law School continuing legal education
- 4 program; he is a member of Brookhollow Baptist Church, and in all
- 5 his endeavors, he enjoys the love and support of his daughter,
- 6 Ashley Paige Turner; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Combining both idealism and pragmatism,
- 8 Representative Turner has gained a well-deserved reputation as "the
- 9 conscience of the house," serving as a passionate and eloquent
- 10 voice for Texans from all walks of life, and his accomplishments
- 11 will continue to benefit countless citizens in the years to come;
