## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to an exemption from the sales tax for firearms and hunting 3 supplies for a limited period. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended 6 by adding Section 151.358 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 151.358. FIREARMS AND HUNTING SUPPLIES FOR LIMITED PERIOD. (a) In this section, "hunting supplies" means ammunition, 8 archery equipment, hunting blinds and stands, hunting decoys, 9 10 firearm cleaning supplies, gun cases and gun safes, hunting optics, and hunting safety equipment. 11 12 (b) The sale of a firearm or hunting supplies is exempted 13 from the taxes imposed by this chapter if the sale takes place during a period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the Saturday of the last 14 15 full weekend in August and ending at 12 midnight on the following Sunday. 16 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Section 151.358, Tax Code, 17 (a) as added by this Act, if this Act takes effect September 1, 2015, 18 the exemption provided by that section from the taxes imposed by 19 Chapter 151, Tax Code, applies to a sale that takes place during a 20 period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the Friday before the first full 21

22 weekend in September 2015 and ending at 12 midnight on the following 23 Sunday if the sale otherwise meets the requirements of that 24 section.

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1 (b) If this Act receives the vote necessary for immediate 2 effect as provided by Section 4 of this Act, this section has no 3 effect.

4 (c) If this section takes effect, this section expires5 October 1, 2015.

6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act does not 7 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this 8 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been 9 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the 10 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of 11 the liability for those taxes.

12 SECTION 4. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this 13 Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of 14 all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, 15 Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the 16 vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect 17 September 1, 2015.

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
