- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 552.1081 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 552.1081. EXCEPTION: CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN
- 9 INFORMATION REGARDING EXECUTION OF CONVICT. Information is
- 10 <u>excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021 if it contains</u>
- 11 identifying information under Article 43.14, Code of Criminal
- 12 Procedure, including that of:
- (1) any person who participates in an execution
- 14 procedure, including a person who uses supplies or administers a
- 15 substance during the execution; and
- 16 (2) any person or entity that manufactures, compounds,
- 17 prescribes, dispenses, or provides a substance or supplies used in
- 18 an execution.
- 19 SECTION 2. Article 43.14, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 Art. 43.14. EXECUTION OF CONVICT: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION
- 22 [CONVICT]. (a) Whenever the sentence of death is pronounced
- 23 against a convict, the sentence shall be executed at any time after
- 24 the hour of 6 p.m. on the day set for the execution, by intravenous

- 1 injection of a substance or substances in a lethal quantity
- 2 sufficient to cause death and until such convict is dead, such
- 3 execution procedure to be determined and supervised by the director
- 4 of the correctional institutions division of the Texas Department
- 5 of Criminal Justice.
- 6 (b) The name, address, and other identifying information of
- 7 the following is confidential and excepted from disclosure under
- 8 Section 552.021, Government Code:
- 9 (1) any person who participates in an execution
- 10 procedure described by Subsection (a), including a person who uses
- 11 supplies or administers a substance during the execution; and
- 12 (2) any person or entity that manufactures, compounds,
- 13 prescribes, dispenses, or provides a substance or supplies used in
- 14 an execution.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 16 a request for information that is received by a governmental body or
- 17 an officer for public information on or after the effective date of
- 18 this Act. A request for information that was received before the
- 19 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 20 date the request was received, and the former law is continued in
- 21 effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
