Relating to the powers, rights, and duties of the Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 2.

HB 3220 Martinez, "Mando"
Relating to the powers and duties of the Hidalgo County Water Control and Improvement District No. 18; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose fees and taxes; providing authority to participate in water planning and conservation projects related to the district within and outside district boundaries; and providing other powers related to roads, water, sewer, recycled water, and related utilities.

HB 3548 VanDeaver

Relating to the authority of the TexAmericas Center to incorporate a nonprofit corporation for certain purposes and to the tax treatment of such a nonprofit corporation.

HB 4126 Zerwas

Relating to the creation of the Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 218; granting a limited power of eminent domain; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose assessments, fees, and taxes.
