SB 1791 Ellis Relating to disclosures on selection or modification of an account by a customer of a financial institution. SB 1792 Ellis Relating to access to a financial institution account of a person who dies intestate. SB 1939 Huffman Relating to contributions to, benefits from, and the administration of systems and programs administered by the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.
