A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to bonuses and salaries for public school classroom
- 3 teachers and state assistance for the Texas Public School Employees
- 4 Group Insurance Program.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Sections 21.417 and 21.418 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 21.417. CLASSROOM TEACHER STATE CAREER BONUS.
- 9 (a) Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for
- 10 purposes of this section, the agency shall provide an annual bonus
- 11 to each classroom teacher with at least six years of teaching
- 12 experience at the beginning of the school year during which the
- 13 bonus is provided.
- 14 (b) The amount of the bonus provided to each classroom
- 15 teacher during any school year shall be established by
- 16 appropriation, and the appropriation may provide for different
- 17 bonus amounts during a school year based on the number of years of
- 18 teaching experience.
- 19 <u>(c) A bonus provided to a classroom teacher under this</u>
- 20 <u>section is not considered in determining whether a school district</u>
- 21 is paying the teacher the minimum monthly salary under Section
- 22 21.402.
- 23 (d) The agency shall provide a bonus under this section only
- 24 to a person employed as a classroom teacher at the time the bonus is

- 1 paid.
- 2 Sec. 21.418. CLASSROOM TEACHER SALARY INCREASES. (a) From
- 3 state funding designated specifically for purposes of this section,
- 4 including a separate appropriation in the General Appropriations
- 5 Act or a designation of revenue provided by the Texas Constitution,
- 6 a school district shall spend an amount equal to the product of
- 7 \$1,000 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers employed by
- 8 the district to increase salaries for classroom teachers in a
- 9 manner determined by the board of trustees to be beneficial to the
- 10 district.
- 11 (b) The commissioner may adopt rules necessary to implement
- 12 this section, provided that the rules do not restrict the manner in
- 13 which the amount described by Subsection (a) is used by a school
- 14 district to increase salaries for classroom teachers.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) The amount of \$193,000,000 of the
- 16 unencumbered appropriations from the general revenue fund for the
- 17 state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2019, made by S.B. 1, Acts
- 18 of the 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017 (the General
- 19 Appropriations Act), to the Health and Human Services Commission is
- 20 transferred to the Texas Education Agency to be used by the agency
- 21 to provide the following bonuses to public school classroom
- 22 teachers under Section 21.417, Education Code, as added by this
- 23 Act:
- 24 (1) a bonus of \$600 to be paid in September 2018 for
- 25 each classroom teacher with at least 6 but less than 11 years of
- 26 teaching experience at the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year;
- 27 and

- 1 (2) a bonus of \$1,000 to be paid in September 2018 for
- 2 each classroom teacher with at least 11 years of teaching
- 3 experience at the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year.
- 4 (b) The Health and Human Services Commission shall identify
- 5 the strategies and objectives out of which the transfer under
- 6 Subsection (a) of this section is to be made.
- 7 SECTION 3. (a) The amount of \$212,000,000 of the
- 8 unencumbered appropriations from the general revenue fund for the
- 9 state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2019, made by S.B. 1, Acts
- 10 of the 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017 (the General
- 11 Appropriations Act), to the Health and Human Services Commission is
- 12 transferred to the Teacher Retirement System of Texas and may be
- 13 used by the retirement system during that state fiscal biennium to
- 14 provide support to participants in the Texas Public School
- 15 Employees Group Insurance Program authorized by Chapter 1575,
- 16 Insurance Code. The Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 17 identify the strategies and objectives out of which the transfer is
- 18 to be made.
- 19 (b) The Teacher Retirement System of Texas may use the money
- 20 transferred under Subsection (a) of this section to:
- 21 (1) reduce costs for participants, including
- 22 premiums, deductibles, and prescription drugs, during the 2018 and
- 23 2019 plan years; and
- 24 (2) reduce the premium and maximum out-of-pocket cost
- 25 for an enrolled adult child with a mental disability or a physical
- 26 incapacity during the 2018 and 2019 plan years.
- 27 (c) The Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall determine

- 1 the most efficient allocation of the money transferred under
- 2 Subsection (a) of this section to achieve the maximum benefit for
- 3 participants in the program.
- 4 SECTION 4. (a) Section 21.417, Education Code, as added by
- 5 this Act, applies beginning with the 2018-2019 school year.
- 6 (b) Section 21.418, Education Code, as added by this Act,
- 7 applies beginning with the 2019-2020 school year.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 13 legislative session.
